We must ensure that there is a balance maintained between the needs of the wildlife and the requirements of the service that is being provided. Sometimes conservation and essential engineering works are not compatible, however, CCS will always work to minimise our impact on the environment.

### *We will;*

1. Reduce air, land and noise pollution from our own activities.
2. Reduce the need to travel and encourage and promote walking, cycling, improved and integrated public transport.
3. Work hard to preserve, restore and enhance the built and natural environment and make it safe, healthy, attractive and accessible for all.
4. Reduce the consumption of goods and materials, avoid waste, conserve, re-use or recycle resources, as appropriate.
5. Use the most environmentally responsible goods and services consistent with good performance and encourage all our contractors and suppliers to do the same.
6. Use our influence to prevent or limit environmental accidents.
7. Train key staff and educate all our staff about their environmental responsibilities and our priorities and programmes.
8. Provide Transport for London with information on the state of the North Central TLRN environment.
9. Comply with all relevant legislation, regulation and policy commitments.
10. Encourage all individuals, organisations and agencies over whom we have influence to adopt, wherever practicable, similar policies and practices.
11. Set up a framework for monitoring, reviewing and updating environmental objectives and targets.
